MEETING NOTES

March 13, 2006

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Peggi Kamisato, Jim Lutter, Keith Wallis, LynnTaylor, Laura Dierenfield

1. Lalamilo Research Station - need to check with Kaz where the easement is going to be and where the trail alignment is. If it is along the north boundary all the way to the Nature Park, we will have to build a bridge on the east end, then if we extend the trail to the LRS bridge, we will have to put another bridge there to avoid using their bridge - that doesn't seem very smart. One key is whether the trail works along the north side or not because of topography.
2. Magoon - James says Corp Counsel cannot locate the signed deed agreements and is searching for it. May have to go back to Alan Okamoto. If we cannot find it, we'll have to start over again!!!! May be 2 to 3 months!!! Got to keep on top of this.
3. STIP - WT&G in fiscal year 2007 is slotted for \$500K in design funds and \$750K in construction funding. Is there construction funding beyond that? that is not that much money. We need to check that out - Clem to call Ann Peterson.
4. The Lodge - Kaz with the manager there, Needs to go further and talk to managing company.
5. We will be on the next meeting of the Board of Parker School Trust to discuss the trail. Need to remind Waimea Center of possible bridge if they can help put that in over the stream.
6. Waikoloa triathalon - discussed times for manning the logo sales. We can have our ddisplay up - Lynn said she has an old map but we could use it if we like.
