MEETING NOTES

November 13, 2006

1. Magoon, County, Catholic Church - the Council action was a resolution to accept the consolidation and resubdivision, the Mayor does not have to sign that - now the Corp Counsel is reviewing and will record the transaction and that must go to the Mayor for his signature.
2. We want to make this a subject of a news release and have contacted Carolyn Lucas - she did not come to our meeting but was invited - Clem will follow up.
3. Parker Ranch - have not heard from Riley - James will follow up with him.
4. Lodge:
 - Connecting the east with the west side of Lindsey Road under the bridge - we feel this is critical because people will jay walk across Lindsey instead of going to the traffic light and this could be a dangerous thing. There seems to be a lot of room for the continuation of the trail under the bridge.
 - Either the Lodge or Paniolo Country Inn is putting their new propane tank right next to the dumpster at the entrance to their establishments - this would prohibit the trail from being in this area. We should discuss with them that this is probably not a very nice entry feature!
 - Lodge easement - there seems to be a snag here with no decision being made
 - let's find out what the County can offer as tax benefit, present it to the trust officer and get this moving - we're going to drag this out so everyone forgets what was said - we need to pursue this with front burner urgency!!!!
5. Our last meeting of the year - 2 Mondays from now will be at Clem's house - pot luck, same time, bring spouses. We will take December off.
