

# Waimea Trails and Greenways

## MEETING NOTES

February 26, 2007

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Jim Lutter, Laura Direnfield, Avi Okin, Lynn Taylor,

1. Tee shirts - Avi has the tee shirts. Jim volunteered to keep an eye open for opportunities to sell the tee shirts at local events and organize manning a table or information table at events.
2. Avi to have a call into Carter Center about the revetment.
3. James (2-27-07) has emailed the preliminary drawings to Clem and would like comments to include to the consultant by Friday.
4. Clem has talked to Pete Hoffman who said he will support any trail effort and funding. He said to wait for the drawings to be completed before we ask for construction money or more money so we will know what to ask for. For now we will work with the consultant, if things change, ie deadlines are not met, we may have to take another tack.
5. Lodge and Parker School - got a phone call from Tony Smart who said Rick Lee is gone from Bank of Hawaii and a new trust officer - John O'Wichisor is not in charge. Kaz will talk to him this week to further the negotiations with the Lodge. Clem brought up that the trail under the bridge and coming up onto the Lodge property may be easier to do by informal, use induced methods.
6. Kaz gave Clem a sign proposal - the committee has the following comments:
  - simplify the language if possible
  - first bullet could read "No motorized vehicles except for wheel chairs on the trail"
  - second bullet could read " Proceed at your own risk"
  - third - "Cyclists shall yield to pedestrians."
7. Clem has a call in to the Mayor to thank him for the time line and to see if construction on phase 1 can start before the end of his administration.
8. Laura will become a part time ED of Path. She also does their web site and will look into putting our tee shirts on their site for sale. She will also come up with an agreement between PATH and WT&G before we hand over the check.
9. Where is the County with Parker Ranch right now on reviewing their offer?
10. Leningrad suggests we think about a name for the trail.
