

Waimea Trails and Greenways

MEETING NOTES

June 25, 2007

1. Parker Ranch agreement - Kaz has a call into Diane Noda as to the status of the easement document.
 2. County Public Access, Open Space and Natural Resources Preservation Commission - Bob Hunter's CDP committee has nominated Waimea Trails and Greenways as one of the projects to be on the list of recipients of the 2% set aside.
Laura will give Clem letters of support that we got last year to present to the Mayor. We will include this with Bob's submission.
 3. Lynn suggests we post maps of the WT&G route in various places in town - library, schools, at the Shopping centers to make people more aware.
 4. Tommy Sing will talk to his Kauai friends who made the trail in Kauai and see if we can duplicate that on the Big Island - Clem pointed out that is what we tried to do by visiting the Mayor last year and no results. Tommy suggests if that didn't work, we go above the Mayor, get some other politician involved - maybe State.
 5. Tee shirts - sell them for \$10. New design - Leningrad went to a tee shirt web site and gave some examples of tee shirt designs.
 6. This led to a discussion of name of the trail - is Waimea Trails and Greenways the name of the trail or the name of the committee? It was felt that the organization can be WT&G but the trail should have a name and that it should be a Hawaiian name. Leningrad suggested a name that is discriptive of where the trail is "Ke Ala kaha Wai O Waimea" Stream Trail of Waimea". Jim motioned that we forward to Parks and Recreation a name designation for the trail once we have one. We will try to have this done by the end of summer - August 31. The motion was seconded and carried.
