MEETING NOTES

June 25, 2007

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Tommy Sing, Lynn Taylor, Leningrad Elarionoff, Laura Dierenfield, Avi Okin, Peggi Kamisato

1. Parker Ranch agreement - James said he got comments back from Diane Noda but has to follow up to see where this is - one of the questions was where will the fence go.
2. Tommy Sing talked to his friend on Kauai. Their trail is 22 miles long and is one third in place. The Mayor was solidly behind the trail. Laura said Thomas Noyes, an HPA grad is in charge of the trail group that shepards the trail.
3. Name of the trail - Leiningrad will talk to Larry Kimura about an appropriate name for the trail. He asked if we want a descriptive name or some other idea. The Hawaiians would have called this Kaha Waikoloa for the tumbling noise of the stream - this would be confusing because of the present day Waikoloa community. Laura suggested Kepa Mali as another resource.
4. July 7 from 11 to 5:00 HPA: Green fest.
5. Last September the Mayor said he would support the trail through insuring funding is intact and that a time line be created (by Roy Takemoto). We would like to see an update of that time line and see when we can expect construction to begin. James said Bruce promises a pre-final drawing for increment 1 by July 27, 2007. What are the review and approval requirements after that? These should be put on a time line so we make sure we don't miss any of the steps. james - who does such a time line? Roy? Kaz?
