July 16, 2007

1. Parker Ranch agreement - James said Diane Noda has formally handed everything over to Renee at Corp Counsel. Is Alan Okamoto working on the corrections? When will he be done?
2. Laura contacted Thomas Noyes about the Kauai Trail - it is not 1/3 done, it is mostly in place around Lydgate Park - they are having problems with a rock fall area.
3. Name of the trail - Laura said this would probably not be a good time to talk to Kepa Mali about naming the trail
4. Kirsten Whatley is writing a book on volunteer opportunities for tourists - we are not ready for this since we have no trail at this time.
5. Schedule - we would like to see if we can get an update from Roy or Kaz or James - whoever is supposed to be tracking the progress of the trail. We would like to get one, two or all three of them to one of our meetings to talk to us about the status of the trail. We would like to know the status of each piece of land, what needs to be done to complete the procurement process and when that will be done.
6. STIP - came out in the paper that WT&G was pushed back as far as funding goes on the STIP. How does this work? Why was the project pushed back? Will we not be able to start construction in fall of 2008? James says that he put in for \$2million out of the County CIP money. How does this work? STIP meeting will be in Waimea August 7, 2007.
