Waimea Trails and Greenways MEETING NOTES

November 5, 2007

- 1. Waimea Outdoor Circle there is a lot of rumor about the impasse between the Outdoor Circle and WT&G gong through the Nature Park. Although the WT&G does not have power of decision making, we should try to get a meeting of the 2 groups to discuss the issues and come up with what would be acceptable to both groups. The issues are:
 - a. ADA compliance
 - b. Trail surface (concrete approved)
 - c. Hard surface at least 15 feet from base of "important" trees. Hard to do in a 30 foot easement.
 - d. New requirements from different people and as we move forward
 - e. Liability if trees stay, County can't be responsible, would Outdoor Circle?
 - f. Trees removal, replacement, important trees, distance to base
 - g. Outdoor Circle trying to control off site things trees off site, wind, flood
 - h. Redesign of the trail to fit Outdoor Circle's new requirements causes delay resurveying, redesign (following old pavement rather than using the design that the engineer came up with)
 - i. Maintenance first right of refusal what does this mean, does OC want to maintain the trail through the Nature Park or are they willing to let it go to some other organization of volunteers?
 - j. Relocation of anything the OC has installed within the easement that may get damaged or cut up trees that have been planted, irrigation, signs,etc.
 - k. Meandering trail rather than straight.

Next week we will not meet - it is a holiday but see if we can meet with the Outdoor Circle the following Monday at our meeting place November 12.
