

# Waimea Trails and Greenways

## MEETING NOTES

June 16, 2008

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Lynn Taylor, Leningrad Elarionoff, Peggi Kamisato, Tommy Sing, Avi Okin

1. Open Space and Trail Alliance - a new organization that is devoted to just what its name implies. They will have an organizational meeting July 12, 2008 at Keck - we all agree that we should find out more about this - Clem and Peggi will attend and report back.
2. Pam Mizuno of Parks and Rec said that they would not like to spend the money on temporary fencing that needs to be dug up and reinstalled later - she will check Friends of the Park Fund. The key is to find out who has jurisdiction over the Lalamilo Research Station - Harry Yada was to come back from vacation today and Leningrad will follow up.
3. Clem called David Imata to see where he was at with the drawings. He did receive our comments and has yet to make the adjustments to the plan. He said he did not see a problem with wigging and wagging the trail around trees - it will be Mike Kraus's call about whether a tree should stay or not. He will find out when the survey crew can go out and mark the CL of the trail - maybe in a week or 2 - Clem to follow up. He will walk the trail with our group once they have marked it.
4. Avi has composed a letter to the Fire Department requesting First Aid assistance during our workday - has not yet heard back from the Fire chief.
5. Clem has spoken to Pastor Tony of the Episcopal Church - he is all for getting members of the church to help with the work day.
6. Leningrad has composed a letter to businesses and individuals requesting assistance and sponsorship of our workday.
7. Clem mentioned that Carol Hendricks of Outdoor Circle notified him that last week a car was seen going into the Nature Park along the path that the trail will be, went into the Lalamilo Research Station and took some illegal plants out of the ground then left. She said we need to be sure that we prohibit access to the trail with bollard that can be removed for County purposes.
