July 28, 2008

1. July 27 workday - was a great success - we put up about 300 feet of fence at the Lalamilo Research Station and cleared the trail way in preparation for the work day September 27. Leningrad has given Milton Yamisato a release for the workday workers.
 2. Clem met with Carl Sturgis of Parker School - he said they will be applying for their Uses permit soon and knows that the trail will be part of it, only needs to decide where the trail will go. **He said WT&G needs to take a proactive role in easement request. James, we need to get on this.** He asked where we were with the Lodge and I told me what our situation was with Kaz not showing any interest and not returning calls - **James we need to find a strategy on how to proceed with this.**
 3. Old govt Road - Debbie Chang is working on getting this into the forefront of peoples minds before we loose this to adjacent landowners.
 4. Leningrad reports that the County has agreed to get a couple of machines in the trail area to clear heavy trees and brush tomorrow - we have approved Leningrad to buy lunches.
 5. Work day:

 - Laura will also put the announcement in Patti Cooks newsletter, a press release soon and another one in September.
 - Clem should call Bob Fewell he has volunteered to take photos.

 - Clem Has contacted Episcopal Church, Catholic Church, Parker School and will contact HPA. Peggi will contact CFHT.
