- 1. This weekend, Leningrad, Avi and Clem helped chip trees in the Nature Park. The Nature Park gave Waimea Trails and Greenways 1 load of chips enough to extend the wood chips on the trail 60 feet. Furture wood chips will have to come from donations by landscapers or from our own chipping.
- 2. Leningrad points out if money cannot pay for everything the trail is designed for, our priorities should be 1 stream crossings, 2 fencing, 3 tree trimming.
- 3. Fencing Leningrad says we have money for fencing. James says that we need to find out where Parker Ranch (Brandie) wants the fence, he will have David Imata draw it, we can then you ahead and hire someone to installe the fence and pay for it with the money Leningrad talks about. Leningrad has a plan for fencing the stream crossing.
- 4. Simulus money in order to qualify for the \$600,000 stimulus money, the trail has to be on the STIP. James received drawings from Imata last Friday for the trail and will go to a meeting on Wednesday with the State DOT to try to get the trail back on the STIP.
- 5. James got the SCAP draft application from David Imata last Friday also.
- 6. Workday looks like the weekend would be May 17. We need the fence in place first.
