Mayor Keno said he talked with Brennon Morioka who said he will have the WT&G project put back on the next revision of the STIP. This will qualify us for \$600,000 in the fed stimulus money. We have a question about whether the original money - \$750,000 will be there for WT&G when we get back on the STIP.
