- 1. Fence Clem talked to Brandy Beaudet he said he will get back to Clem this week and possibly walk the alignment of the fence to get an estimate. We also need to get chain link fencing at Kanu oKa Aina for the next work day.
- 2. Clem sent a letter to the Planning director asking her to impose a condition on Parker School use permit application for a trail easement.
- 3. Make a Difference Day October 23 Aiden Wharton called Clem to see if Parker School students can work on the trail as their project. Clem will coordinate their efforts. They can either 1) prepare the ground and spread wood chips between the Nature Park and Carter Center 2) weed and clear the trail between Carter Center and the stream behind the Catholic Church or 3) clear vegetation along the trail between Nature Park and Opelo Road.
- 4. We will meet behind Carter Center next week to review the work day and clear fallen tree limbs in the steam.
- 5. Meeting with Mayor and Bob Fitzgerald last Thursday was very encouraging

He suggested getting all parties who are working on this - State Transportation, Federal Highways, County Parks and Rec, the Consultant, our committee, together in one room to talk face to face on what needs to be done, who is to do it and get it done.

Our committee will be given the opportunity to discuss this with them and help determine if the County bond float money is best used to put something on the ground or to do further studies.

The Moyor is having his people set up the meeting - it should be after October 17.
