Waimea Trails and Greenways MEETING NOTES

January 11, 2010

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Leningrad Elarionoff, Peggi Kamisato, Debbie Chang, Bobby Command, Bob Fitzgerald

1. Fence

- Brandi Beaudet said that the trail through the Parker Ranch area between Opelo Road and Kahawai Street cannot be opened to the public until the permanent fence is installed. Parker Ranch put up a temporary agricultural fence so we could put up the permanent fence.
- The committee thinks the permanent fence should go down by the stream so most of the easement is usable. Imata would like the fence above the flood zone which would put it right next to the tread surface, crowding the trail and giving up a large part of the easement. This also puts the trail closer to the residences.
- Bobby Command is going to talk to Imata and Kimura to see if putting the permanent fence puts the future prospects of using federal funds in jeopardy. He is also going to find out if the fence in the flood zone (not flood way) would be a problem with the regulations.

2. Consultant

- Kimura is ready to execute the contract. The County is working on it and expects it to be completed this week or next week. They will give us a scope of work for our review.
- They have authorized an aerial survey to obtain a 2 foot contour of the study area.
- Time schedule 6 to 9 months for completion. Army Corps requirements may add 6 months.
- Imata work may run simutaneous but they do not want to waste engineering time so they may not be able to do too much.
- Archeological work Bobby does not think there is a lot of stuff to worry about but the old pavement to Camp Tarawa may be a historic feature.
- Kimura will do face to face interviews with people and may solicit our help in contacting people who may have concerns about the

trail.

- They would like to see if there are other historic trails that would connect to the Ala Kahakai trail - like the old Puako- Waimea Trail.

3. Communication

- Bobby Command will be in weekly contact with the consultant team.
- Clem will get a status report from Bobby on a weekly basis preferably Monday before our weekly meeting.
