

# Waimea Trails and Greenways

## MEETING NOTES

February 22, 2010

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Peggi Kamisato, Leningrad Elarionoff

1. Consultant - Kimura International meeting notes from the February 8 meeting:
  - on page one under flooding, the notes say that Fran Tabor notes the water rose to 3 feet deep in the middle of town. Leningrad disputes that and that cars were driving in this water - it may have been 12 to 18" deep at the main interesection.
  - top of page 3 Clem said the landowner (UH - Ag extention service) did not want the trail along the south side of the Waikoloa Stream through their property - that would have been the prefered alignment.
2. We went through and marked up the 3 maps given to us to show:
  - corrections in the preferred alignment
  - corrections to the easements obtained and which are not acquired
  - destination points the trail can connect to
  - alternatives to the preferred alignment
  - extentions of the trail
3. KI will meet with the committee next Monday to begin their field study.
