- 1. Walked the trail from Carter Center to South Kohala View estates to look at present alignment and alternatives close to the trail easement.
- 2. Minimizing number of stream crossings would be a major goal.
- 3. Revisit certain right of ways due to change in ownership or control of land to achieve goal.
- 4. Lalamilo Research station see if we can keep the trail on the south side of the stream and connect at existing bridge within the LRS.
- 5. See if Parker Ranch would be amenable for the County to put the fence above the flood way on their side of the stream so we can have use of the entire easement. Why is the easement in this form instead of in fee since it is part of Parker Ranch's requirement to provide a certain amount of land for recreation purposes as part of their development deal.
- 6. Alternatives through Sandalwood as proposed by Fran Tabor.
- 7. Cross over from Parker Ranch easement to state land at Transfer station may need to get additional easement from Parker Ranch or Hori (Chris Robb) farmlot.
- 8. Revisit with Chris Robb the possibility of making the trail through his farm lot along the stream deleting the need for another stream crossing.
- 9. Next work day may have to be held off to see where the fence can be located.
- 10. Schedule Final EA submittal for approval in September of 2010.
