

# Waimea Trails and Greenways

## MEETING NOTES

April 19, 2010

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Peggi Kamisato, Avi Okin, Tommy Sing, Margaret Willie, Bob Fitzgerald, Bobby Command

1. Reviewed Glenn Kimura's schedule - he is presently reviewing alternatives. Should have the preferred alignment this week. His contract should be finalized. He is waiting for the topo map to be completed.
2. Goal: to have next increment of trail open from Opelo Road to Kahawai Street
  - a. We have a grant from Richard Smart for \$10,000 good until next March to install a fence. We will need County materials but the County can only pay for materials for projects on County property. We will have to raise money for that.
  - b. Fence - makes most sense to have the fence installed on the Parker Ranch side of the stream so we can use the whole stream. Bob Fitzgerald is in negotiations with Parker Ranch right now for the regional park and wants to get that signed before approaching them about the trail fence and other trail issues. They should have a signed MOA in 2 months so we will meet again June 28 to discuss where they are at so we can ask Mayor Kenoi to ask Parker Ranch to put the fence on their side outside the flood zone. They would not lose any land, the boundary would remain in the middle of the stream. When they want to develop that land, and remove the cattle, the fence can come down. This will require changing the easement language.
3. Right of ways east of Lindsey Road and west of the transfer station - Bob Fitzgerald will get Ken Van Burgen from the County to work on that - will also get Corp Counsel.
4. Parks and Rec is hiring a new project manager and one of his projects will be WT&G - he will be the one in the County P&R who will attend to all the details and have an overview of what needs to be done to make the trail happen. Bobby Command will keep in touch with him.
5. Kaz Shigezawa contract - what is the status of this - Bobby Command will find out - the question is: "Is there unused money from the

remainder of his contract and if so, can it be put to use to benefit Waimea Trails and Greenways?"
