

# Waimea Trails and Greenways

## MEETING NOTES

June 14, 2010

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Peggi Kamisato, Avi Okin, Leningrad Elarionoff

1. NEPA - alternative routes - we got lots of negative and positive feedback from Kimura's request for comments on alternatives. Only one alternative was shown going through Ohia Ku and Pako subdivision. Kimura should also consider going on the south side of the Keanuiomano stream between South Kohala View Estates and the Transfer station as well as along the Lalamilo Farm lots where the 80 foot easement is located.
2. Parker Ranch has offered to put the fence between the Lalamilo Research Station and Kahawai Street on their side of the stream. Clem's understanding is that Brandi Beaudet also suggested the temporary trail be placed on the south bank of the stream in this area - this is Parker Ranch land and should be verified. Brandi said they can install the fence but would like us to purchase materials. Clem has asked Laura Dierenfield if we could redirect the money from the Richard Smart Grant for this purpose. Also we got left over money from the anonymous donor for fence materials for a work day.
3. Bobby Command said that the County is checking with their Corp Counsel to see if this is something the County can do. It should be available by August 28. He should have an answer this week.
4. Based on this we would like to plan our next work day sometime in September.
5. Bobby Command was requested to come to our next meeting on Monday June 21 to fill us in on the Parker Ranch offer and the County's response.
