MEETING NOTES

July 12, 2010

PRESENT: Clem Lam, Peggi Kamisato, Leningrad Elarionoff, Tommy Sing

1. Parker Ranch fence and Corp Counsel - Bobby Command said he has not heard back from Corp Counsel - it has been weeks now - Clem to ask Bobby Command if he can be pro-active in requesting attention to this and get an answer before Parker Ranch withdraws it's offer.
2. Workday - we have 2 choices:
 - a. First choice is to extend the trail from Opelo Road to Kahawai Street.
 - This requires fencing at Parker Ranch as well as through Kanu and the Lalamilo Research Station.
 - ask Bobby Command about getting the County in assisting with the LLRS fence as the permanent fence - it will be on County Easement. There are some Kanu containers in the way.
 - See if we can stage this at the LLRS where Kanu's parking and drop off area is.
 - b. Second choice is to work on the first work day area between Lindsey Road and Opelo Road.
 - There is lots of fallen branches that have been stacked
 - Clear the stream
 - Chip the debris (see if we can get the County chipper through Deac)
 - spread wood chips on the trail over weed cloth
 - c. Logistics
 - Lunch - Leningrad thinks he can talk to people about the food for less cost - chili - veg and chicken
 - Make it an event (Michael Wahlen)- Peggi to talk to Laura and PATH
 - Informational booth
 - Work with Outdoor Circle to coincide with one of their Park concerts
 - 3 hour work time period
 - open it up to general public with announcements
 - have team leaders to breakdown into work groups and sections.
